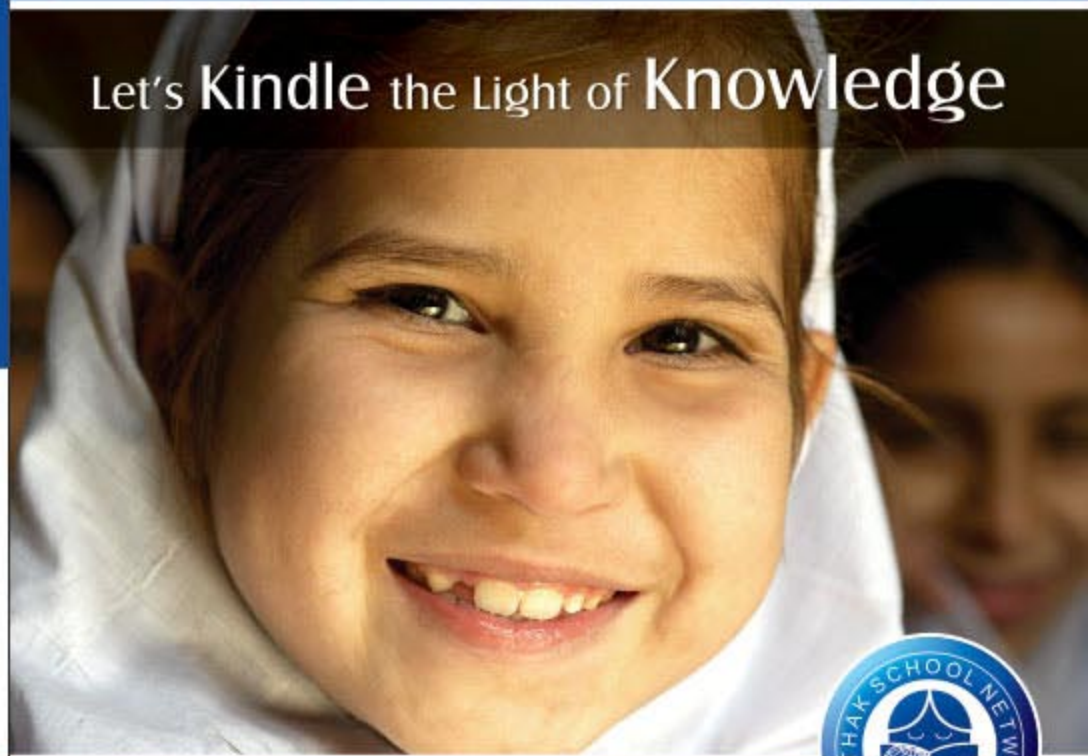

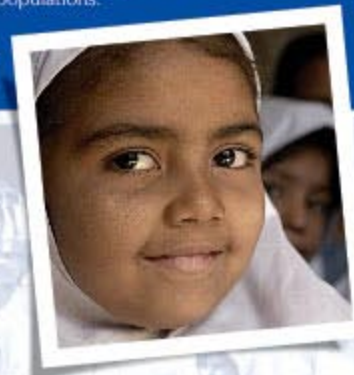
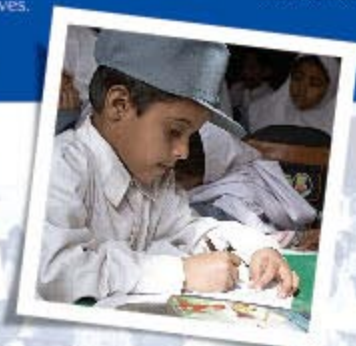

About Us

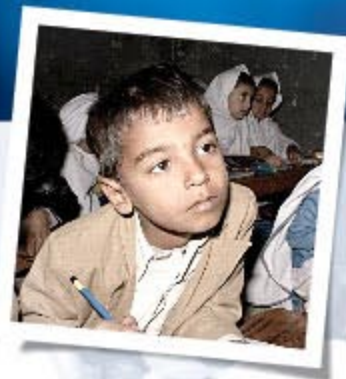
- Established in 1995, in Karachi, the society operates a network of "Community Model Schools" to impart education to the underprivileged children of Pakistani society. SEW's community based welfare network, which initially comprised only a few "Baithak Schools" in 1996, now operate a system of 157 schools all over Pakistan.
- Our team includes dedicated and educated volunteers, who with focused devotion strive hard to achieve our objectives.

The organization runs on self-help basis with no affiliation or continued financial patronage from any global agency. By the grace of Allah, we run our network of low resourced but well organized schools, which are built with the purpose of imparting education as well as vocational training. These community model schools deliver mostly formal, and at some places informal, education. Our schools are situated in the heart of low-income areas having multi-cultural and multi-ethnic populations.



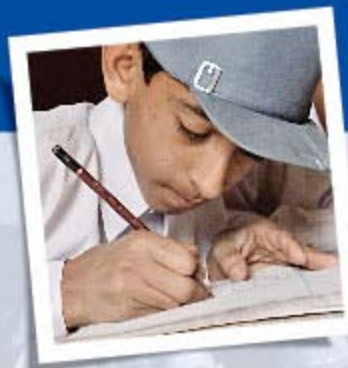

- Providing basic training skills like embroidery, arts and crafts to female students and woodworks, technicians and electricians work to boys to enable them to earn their own living.

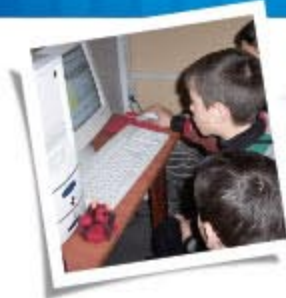


Yearly Growth of Students
